The main EPC window consists of three primary sections: the Illustration, the Parts List, and the Shopping List. Menus and navigation tools provide additional functionality.
* Some features may vary depending on your market.

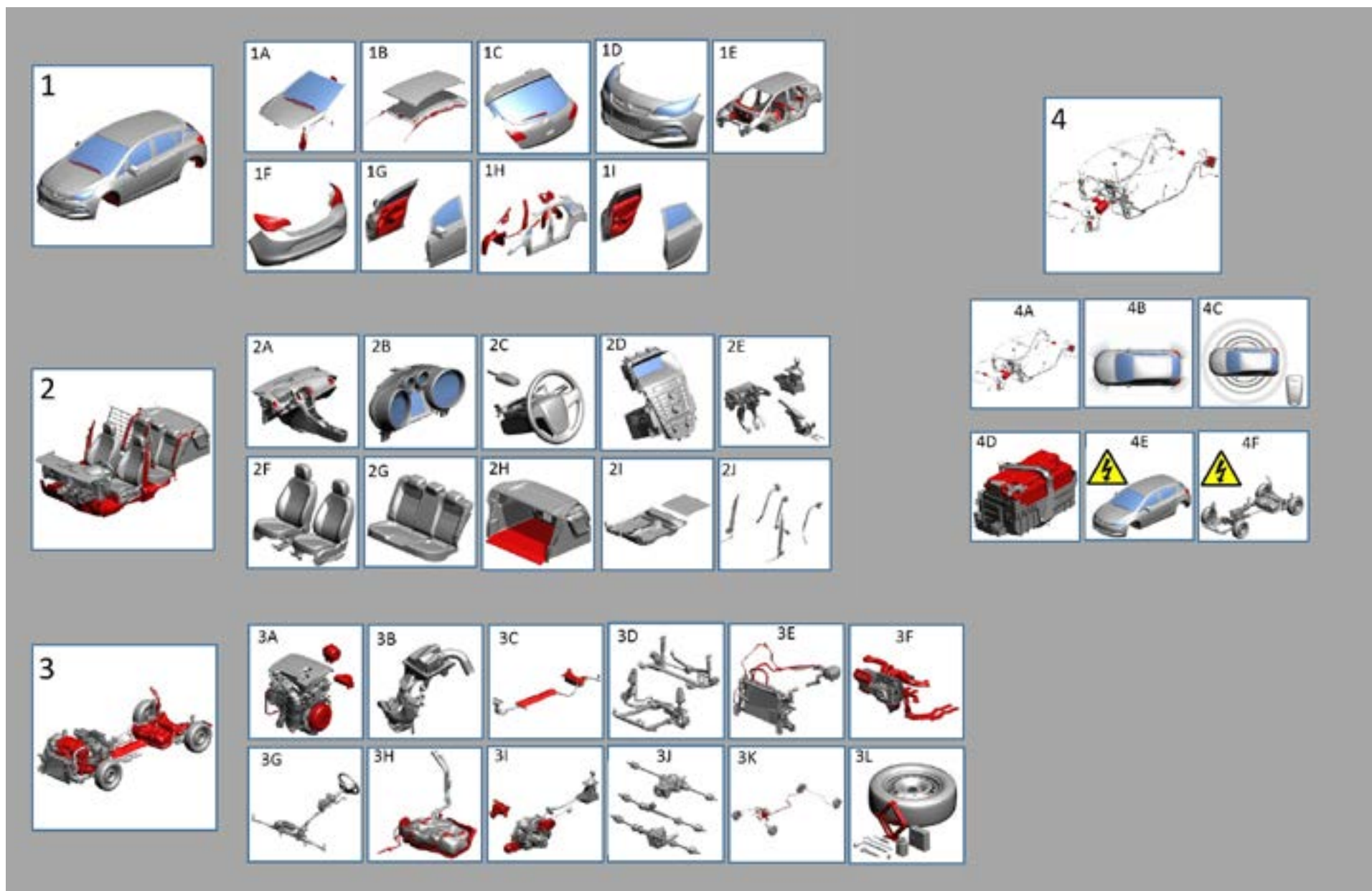
- Displays the navigation path or job name.

- Highlight an illustration callout to display only its part in the part text.
- A circled callout indicates a single-use part.
- * Send the shopping list to your DMS.
- Manage shopping lists.
- Save the shopping list.
- Manually add a part to the shopping list.
- Click to open the Search Results window.
- View a list of fast moving parts for the vehicle.
- Display VIN and RPO Information.
- Enter a shortcut or search term.
- Click arrows for next or previous image.
- Clear selected callouts and show all parts.
- View part usage for selected callouts.
- Add selected parts to a quicklist.
- Open the ACDelco Catalog.
- Click a filter checkbox to remove or apply filtering.
- Click a navigation bar hyperlink to go to its level of navigation.
- Open one of these menus to access EPC tools and features or to change EPC settings.
- Access the EPC Help.
- Print the illustration, parts list, or shopping list.
- Open EPC News and Bulletin Board.
- Type here to filter part results.
- Click a group number to see part usage information.
- Click to view the shopping list in full screen mode.
- Click to remove the part from the shopping list.
- Click to minimize the shopping list.
- Click and drag to resize the panes.
- Click a grey plus icon to add the part to the shopping list.
- * Click a part number to see where else the part is used.
- Set the pricing level displayed in the shopping list.
- Copy all part numbers.
- Create an estimate.
- Email the shopping list.
- Clear all parts from the shopping list.

<i>Open the RPO Search window</i>	<i>Select from the Information menu</i>
<i>Begin a part-number-to-illustration search</i>	<i>Click on a part number</i>
SHOPPING LIST	
<i>Hide/show the shopping list</i>	<i>Select Minimize or Restore icon</i>
<i>Add current part to the shopping list</i>	<i>Insert key</i>
<i>Send shopping list parts to DMS</i>	<i>F2</i>
<i>Price and history for current part number</i>	<i>F9</i>
<i>Remove current part from the shopping list</i>	<i>Delete key</i>
<i>Add a part manually</i>	<i>Click Add Part icon</i>
<i>Toggle List, Trade, Dealer pricing display</i>	<i>Select from Prices drop-down</i>
