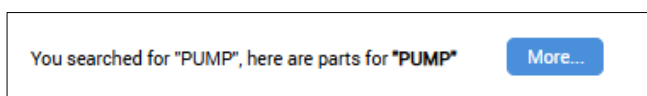


GM Parts Connect September Updates are Here!

We are pleased to announce several enhancements to GM Parts Connect that will be available beginning September 14, 2026. These updates reflect valuable feedback from our users, and we appreciate your continued input. 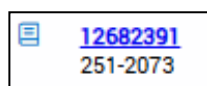
- A “**More...**” button has been added to the part search results list.



By clicking this button, you can broaden your search to include additional parts. Results will include parts where the part term entered appears within the part's description or usage information. This will help to identify additional relevant results.

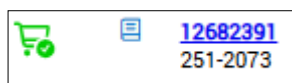
Note: If your search finds only one part, GM Parts Connect will automatically display it. You can still click the search icon where the “More...” button is available to expand your search.

- The Additional Information (Blue Book) icon has been reinstated and will now appear alongside parts when supplemental information is available.



Selecting the icon will display relevant details about the part, including program participation, such as whether the part is included in the **Bump the Competition** program.

- When searching for a part by name, ACDelco Gold and Silver are now displayed with the results.
- The image search functionality has been upgraded to improve the accuracy and reliability of part identification. Now whether the part is installed or not, GM Parts Connect will recognize it.
- The icon identifying parts that have been added to the Shopping Cart has been enhanced for greater visibility, making it easier for users to quickly recognize items already in their cart.



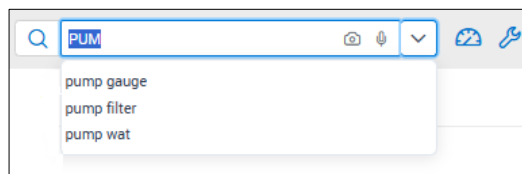
- The group and part name search functionality has been enhanced to allow entry of a group number immediately followed by a full or partial noun name without requiring a space to be entered. For example:
 - “03MODULE” – which only shows modules in group 03. The same search can be run with a space or a period in between (03.MODULE or 03 MODULE)
 - Also, try searching with a partial part name like “03mod”; “03.mod”; “03 mod”
- The type-to-narrow list filtering functionality has been enhanced in two key ways:
 - First, type-to-narrow is now available for ACDelco parts in Picture Mode, in addition to List Mode.
 - Second, you can now filter part lists using multiple search terms with the following qualifiers:
 - Backslash (\): “OR” condition
 - Comma (,): “AND” condition
 - Tilde (~): “NOT” condition

You can enter multiple “AND”, “OR” and “NOT” qualifiers, which are evaluated in the following order:

1. “OR”
2. “AND”
3. “NOT”

These enhancements provide greater flexibility and improved search precision when filtering lists.

- Auto Complete in the “Ask me anything...” search box is now available in thirteen languages, providing search suggestions in all languages.



Note: To enable Autocomplete, open Application Settings, scroll down to Search Settings and select "Auto Complete Search Input".

- Access to the Top 6 Maintenance Parts and Recommended Fluids & Lubricants icons has been improved. They are now available when the Common Names catalog navigation style is used.
- The Top 6 Maintenance Parts icon has been enlarged to improve visibility and make it more easily identifiable to users.
- The option to create an estimate is improved to display only unit price and adjusted price for your customers, as displayed on the final Estimate screen.
- Chat bubble is moved to show all listed part quantities on the illustrated parts list.
- ‘Send Part to D2DLink’ from the right-click menu is no longer greyed out when the integration is available.
- Several dealer management system integration fixes are included.

More Improvements are coming in 2026...

- GM Parts Connect for mobile phones and tablets.
- Pick List, an abbreviated version of the shopping cart.
- Warranty integration to show active vehicle recalls and warranties.
- Component Code searching.
- Dark Mode.
- Upload part photos for submission to GM Parts Connect.

- Neighboring dealer inventory from OEC D2DLink.
